Qus1: why are the first few rulers of the Delhi sultanate called the rulers of the slave dynasty?

And. Qutubuddin Aibak laid the foundation of the slave dynasty.

And. To consolidate his Empire Balban:

- 1. Constructed strong forts along the North West frontier and repair the old ones.
- 2. Kept strong and well equipped standing army.
- 3. Adopted blood and iron policy to control the Rebels and Nobles.
- 4. Used his Sword unrelentingly against rebels, thieves and Invaders to established peace and order in his Empire.
